If you log into <u>CertTracker</u> after 5 business days and are not able to see the *Exams* or *Credentials* tabs then you MUST update/confirm your demographic information by following the below steps.

- From the top menu bar Select Demographics
- Update information (i.e. relation to Dell Technologies, email address, phone number)
- Scroll to the bottom of the page and click Update/Confirm

Once you update/verify your demographic information you will be able to see the *Exams* and *Credentials* tabs with your history listed.
